As members and friends of our religious community, we understand that all persons deserve a safe, and positive environment as part of their religious education experiences. For retreats held at First Unitarian Church as well as off-site trips, the following rules apply:

- 1. There shall be no more than **five** youth for each adult attending.
- 2. Youth must be supervised by two adults at all times.
- 3. Exterior doors will remained locked at all times.
- 4. Sleepovers will be in Gilbert Hall. Classrooms or other areas are not to be entered during an overnight.
- 5. No one is given access to the building who is not known to a chaperone.
- 6. Drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and other illegal or controlled substances are prohibited.
- 7. Church property (such as wheelchairs) is used only for its intended purpose.
- 8. Weapons are prohibited, as are violent or harassing actions or words.
- 9. Engaging in sexual activity or exclusive behavior is prohibited. No shared bedding.
- 10. Once the event has begun, no youth may arrive or leave the building without the approval of the adults in charge. Lock-in hours will be observed.
- 11. All adults must be aware of, sign, and abide by the Code of Ethics.
- 12. Drivers must meet criteria and sign Driver Safety Form.
